

Night Safari: Around 50 people of all ages attended this event on August 18th. Entrance fees raised around £178 which will be equally divided between Wycombe Wildlife, who provided the bat and moth experts and our own church general funds.

The Clock: Following receipt of a Faculty, Smith of Derby Ltd. have installed an Automatic Clock Winding Mechanism and Regulator to the clock in the Tower. Since 1845, volunteers have climbed the steep steps each week and wound the clock by means of a large cracked handle that raised two weights up the tower, one large and one small. We have been fortunate in receiving a donation as well as using money from the dormant Bell Fund to fund this work. (The total cost of this work is £6774.00). The whole system is controlled by a Timer that even adjusts for the two clock changes each year. Our grateful thanks must go to David Baldwin who has been our 'Father Time' for many years.
