### **CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY**

#### **Meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> June**

**ASM Priorities/Vision:** The Church Council continued their discussions surrounding God's vision for ASM and our priorities (both imminent and future). A document was presented by Ruth Julie and Dave and was discussed and refined ready for further discussion next month.

**Children in Communion:** The 4U team are due to meet to decide whether, with appropriate guidance and support, children can receive Holy Communion before they are confirmed; a decision will be made by Team Council on July 10<sup>th</sup>. A draft document 'admission to Holy Communion' was put forward and correspondence received from parishioners was discussed. The Church council were in agreement of the document and for ASM to support it, and the admission of children to Holy Communion.

**Finance:** The Church remains around £18k in deficit for 2018 (based on Q1 figures). The Parish Giving Scheme has now been launched and those currently giving by standing order or blue envelope are being encouraged to switch to this method of giving. It is too early to analyse the impact of this, but we would encourage everyone to consider switching as well as consider the amount of financial support they are giving. Without a considerable increase in our income, we will be unable to continue all the activities and good work we are currently doing and it makes future planning and initiatives very challenging. travels, for safety, and for good relationships and good fun as they spend time with the children and project staff. **Children and Communion** On **July 10<sup>th</sup>** the Team Council of the Parish will be discussing and voting on whether to accept the policy to admit Children to Communion before Confirmation across the Parish.
