The **Electoral Roll** for the ecclesiastical (not Civil) parish of Little Marlow which enables you to be part of the Church's electoral and therefore organisational system, is undergoing major revision this year as happens every 6 years. The existing roll will no longer operate and it will be necessary to reapply to join the new roll.

If you wish to do this, you will need to complete an Electoral Roll form and give it to a churchwarden or Marguerite Fergusson. Forms will be available in the church from 21 January and will need to be returned by 11 March 2019.

There will be a special service to mark Candlemas on Sunday 3 February at 11.00am. This Festival celebrates Mary and Joseph presenting the baby Jesus to the Priest at the Temple according to custom, and we give thanks for Him bringing light into the world. We would especially welcome all those who have been Baptised at St. John the Baptist, Little Marlow and their godparents and families as well as those who wish to give thanks for their Baptism and renew their Baptismal vows. If you have the candle which you may have been given at your baptism, please bring it so that it can be lit with others.
