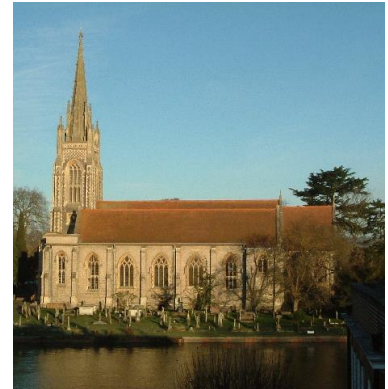
Do you want to spend a year working with a vibrant, multi-generational Anglican church? We are a group of ordinary people but we sense that our extraordinary God is leading us on a journey and we are inviting you to consider joining us on it as a Children's Intern.

The role of a Children's Intern is a fantastic opportunity to explore your gifts and see God use you whilst serving and gaining experience in the context of a local church.

We are a friendly, welcoming church with a wide range of ages and experiences. Some of us have worshipped here for decades. Others are right at the beginning of our spiritual journeys. We enjoy varied worship styles and try to generate a warm, friendly place in which to worship.

It is important to us that you feel at home and part of the All Saints Church family therefore we would provide accommodation for you, offer a subsistence allowance (including paid expenses) as well as regular mentoring and support.

In addition, as part of the New Wine Discipleship Year programme (aimed at 18-24 year olds) you will benefit from teaching, mentoring and coaching and will spend one day a week (Tuesdays) at the New Wine training hub at St Paul's, Ealing. The rest of your time will be spent working alongside our Children's Discipleship Leader in a variety of different settings, including:



- Sunday children's groups;
- opportunity to build relationships with 500+ children at our two church schools who fully embrace our partnership and are very proactive in sharing Jesus with the children in their care;
- our Small Saints worship band – a new initiative giving children the chance to explore worship and lead us in praise;
- Bumps and Babies PRAISE! – a new parent and toddler group aiming to provide a space for the little ones in our community to encounter God, whilst also reaching out to parents with babies and toddlers;
- opportunity to engage with around 50 boys and girls involved in our church choirs.

There would also be opportunities to serve in other areas of church life, such as worship, creative prayer, youth work and communications – dependent on where your heart and giftings lie.

Since the role includes working with children, you will be required to complete a DBS check before you can be appointed. You will also be required to follow our policies and practices for Child Protection, Health and Safety, and any other policies and practices that apply to your work.

To apply, please send a CV (including details of two referees) along with a cover letter which explains why you want to be our intern. Please also describe your Christian faith journey and detail any experience you have which you think is relevant.
